


4TH FLOOR

3RD FLOOR

You will put yourselves in a migrant's shoes and get to know the history of Italian emigration and of recent immigration movements, thanks to reconstructions of different settings, photographs, videos, and interactive stations. On the deck of a steamer, a ship simulator will make you live the exciting experience of manoeuvring a ship in the port of Genoa. Finally, the submariners' school of the S518 Nazario Sauro will prepare you to visit the submarine.



2ND FLOOR

Here you can see the original raft where Ambrogio Fogar and Mauro Mancini remained at the mercy of the ocean for 74 days, and then you will face a 4D storm on board a lifeboat. You can have a look around in the navigation room and get on board a brigantine-schooner; after the historic shipyard and the carpentry, you will enter a late-19th-century Yacht Club, with the paintings of the Croce Collection.

1ST FLOOR

From here, you can see the deck of the galley from above; it ends with the so-called carrozza, which hosted the important passengers. A part of the exhibit evokes the arrival in Genoa of the galleys with chests full of silver, taken from the Spanish monarchy and brought to Andrea Doria. Then, you will admire valuable globes and ancient atlases, which can be looked up thanks to the multimedia stations, allowing to browse the maps drawn by the most famous cartographers of the 16th and 17th century. Finally, the Sea Monsters Room will bring to life the imaginary tales surrounding the sea, between wonder and fear.

GROUND FLOOR

At first glance, you'll notice the new hall of the Galata, recently renovated, evoking the worlds of sea and navigation (see the box on the right). After the rooms dedicated to the Port of Genoa in the past and to Christopher Columbus, where some important documents and his famous portrait are on show, the visit goes on in the Darsena armoury and with a faithful 1:1 reconstruction of a 17th-century galley. The galley is 40 metre long, has a 9-metre-tall stern, and can be explored to find out more about the life of its crew: slaves, convicts and the so-called buonavoglia, paid volunteers.



REGULATIONS FOR VISITING THE SUBMARINE

- 1 The visit to the Submarine is an integral part of the visit to Galata Museo del Mare. There is no ticket for the Submarine alone and it is not possible to visit only that attraction.
- 2 During the visit to the Museum, you will have the chance of visiting the reproduction of a Submarine which is as high and as large as the N. Sauro, including the template of a narrow hatch, which is a preview of what you will see on board the Sauro (pre-show).
- 3 You can buy the ticket Galata + Submarine (or Galata alone, including the pre-show) at the ticket office of the Museum or online; the tours NavigAcquario and AcquarioVillage, which include the visit to the Galata and the Submarine, can be purchased both at the ticket offices of the Museum and the Aquarium;
- 4 Advance booking is required for groups and high-school tours, at Incoming Liguria (telephone 010 2345666, for groups and for all types and levels of school) or at Galata Museo del Mare (telephone 010 2345655, for all types and levels of school). Groups of the elementary and junior high school will have to be accompanied by one or more teachers, consistently with the Didactic Area of the Museum. Groups of the elementary or junior high school can visit the Museum only if they buy tickets for a themed tour or laboratory. Advance booking is required.
- 5 Children under four years of age, disabled and sight-impaired people cannot access the Submarine. It is advised to avoid the visit for people having difficulty in walking, suffering from claustrophobia or wearing shoes with slim heels. For people with special needs, an exceptional way of access may be arranged in advance.
- 6 Before getting on board, visitors will have to hand in a signed consent form and put in the cloakroom bags and other similar items.
- 7 Upon handing in an ID, visitors will be given a helmet and an audio guide for free, to wear during the visit and give back at the end. The audio guide automatically triggers messages at the entrance and in some strategic spots during the visit of the Submarine. In case of groups or schools, the group leader will take on the responsibility of the audio guides given to all members of the group.
- 8 You will go down in the Submarine from the opening and the stairs on the stern, while you will go out from the bow. The average duration of the visit is about 20/25 minutes.
- 9 Through the audio guides, you will be given further instructions that you will have to follow carefully. The Submarine is a work environment and it must be visited carefully and respectfully.



Laboratories, follow-up contents and guided tours are various and fit for every age group: **The history of the Port of Genoa and how it is today, the boats that have made the history of the Republic of Genoa, the 'wrecks finder', the ocean crossings, the scientific instruments, the submarine, the phenomenon of migrations, etc.**

The multitude of activities offered also includes a tour of the **Museoteatro of the Commenda di Prè, Acquario di Genova, the Palazzo del Principe, Dialogo nel Buio and Via del Campo 29 rosso.**

Activities scheduled all year around, upon reservation:
